The Family Emergency Treatment Center offers professional behavioral health care assistance for individuals and families who are in immediate need of evaluation and treatment.

The Center provides services to children, adolescents and adults with personal problems ranging from family and life adjustment difficulties to stress reactions, substance abuse and mental illness.

Provides an alternative resource for the law enforcement officer who has an individual who does not meet Baker Act criteria, yet is in need of a mental health intervention.

The Center is an alternative to costly, time-consuming, and many times inappropriate treatment options such as hospital emergency rooms, crisis units and jails.

The Center seeks to improve the quality of life for the individual by providing an individual treatment prior to their condition deteriorating and allowing them to remain with family and friends in the community.

Fees are charged on a sliding scale basis in accordance to the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Income verification required to receive medication. Not all consumers will receive medication. Referrals are made to the appropriate outpatient, mental health clinic.
