- Earn a living allowance of up to \$12,100, in addition to gaining training and valuable work experience
- Receive a Segal AmeriCorps Education Award for \$5,645 to help pay for college, graduate school, or vocational training or to repay student loans



About AmeriCorps

AmeriCorps members serve their community by working with those in-need and receive a living allowance; health care; childcare, if they qualify; and a Segal AmeriCorps Education Award upon completion of 1 year of service. Since the program's founding in 1994, more than 900,000 AmeriCorps members have contributed more than 1.2 billion hours in service across America while tackling pressing problems and mobilizing millions of volunteers for the organizations they serve.
